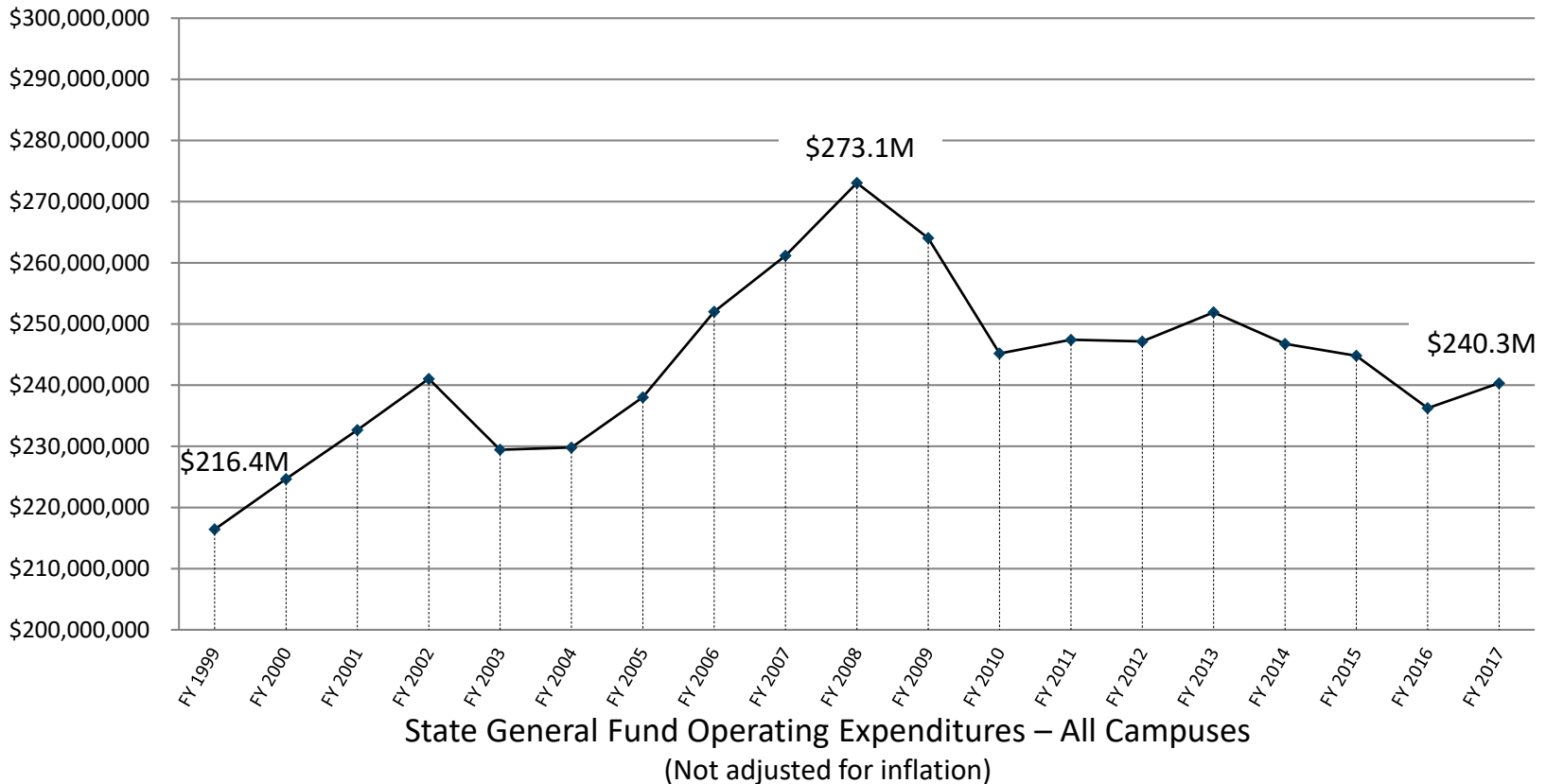

## State funding remains below pre-recession levels

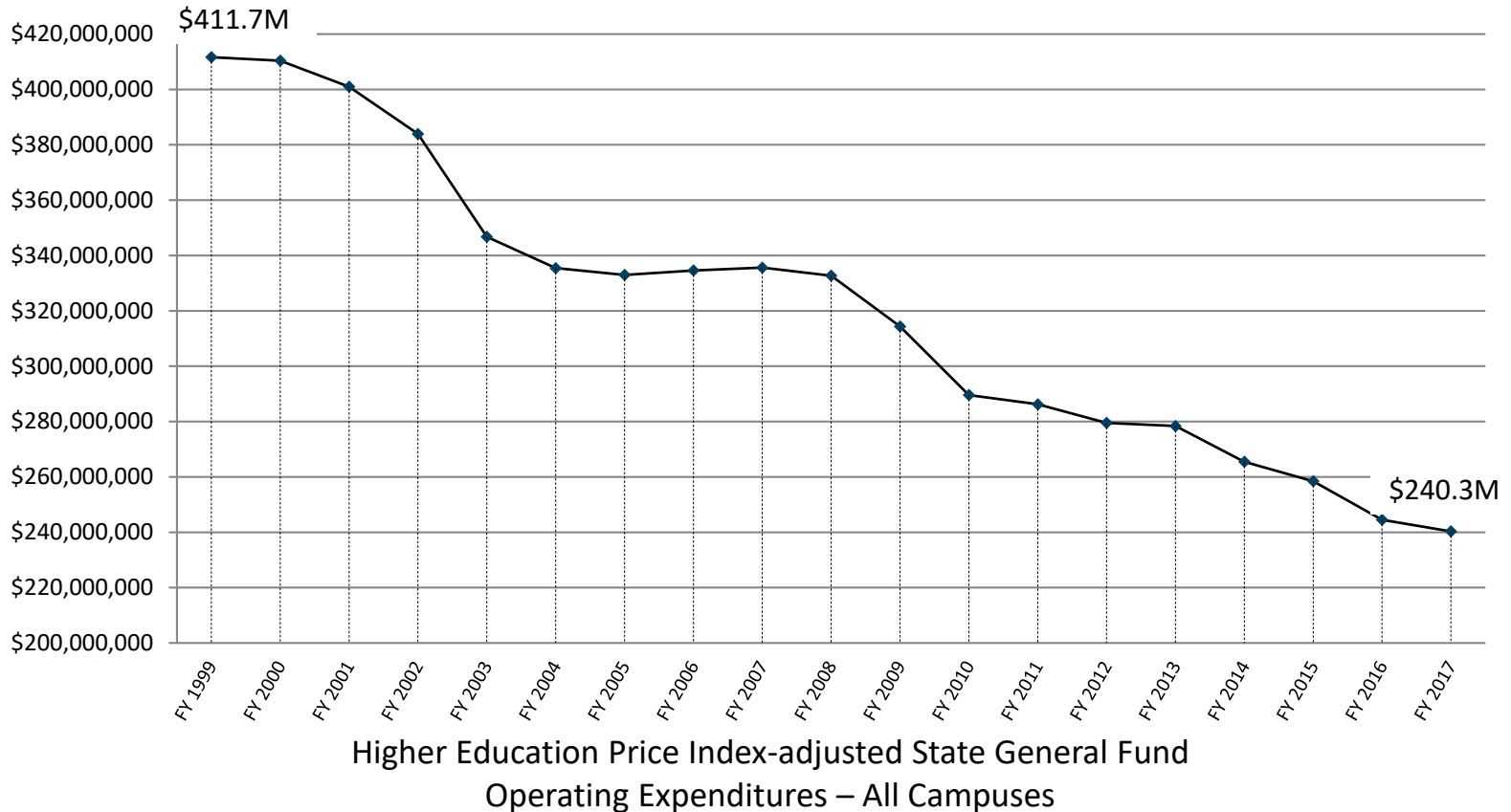

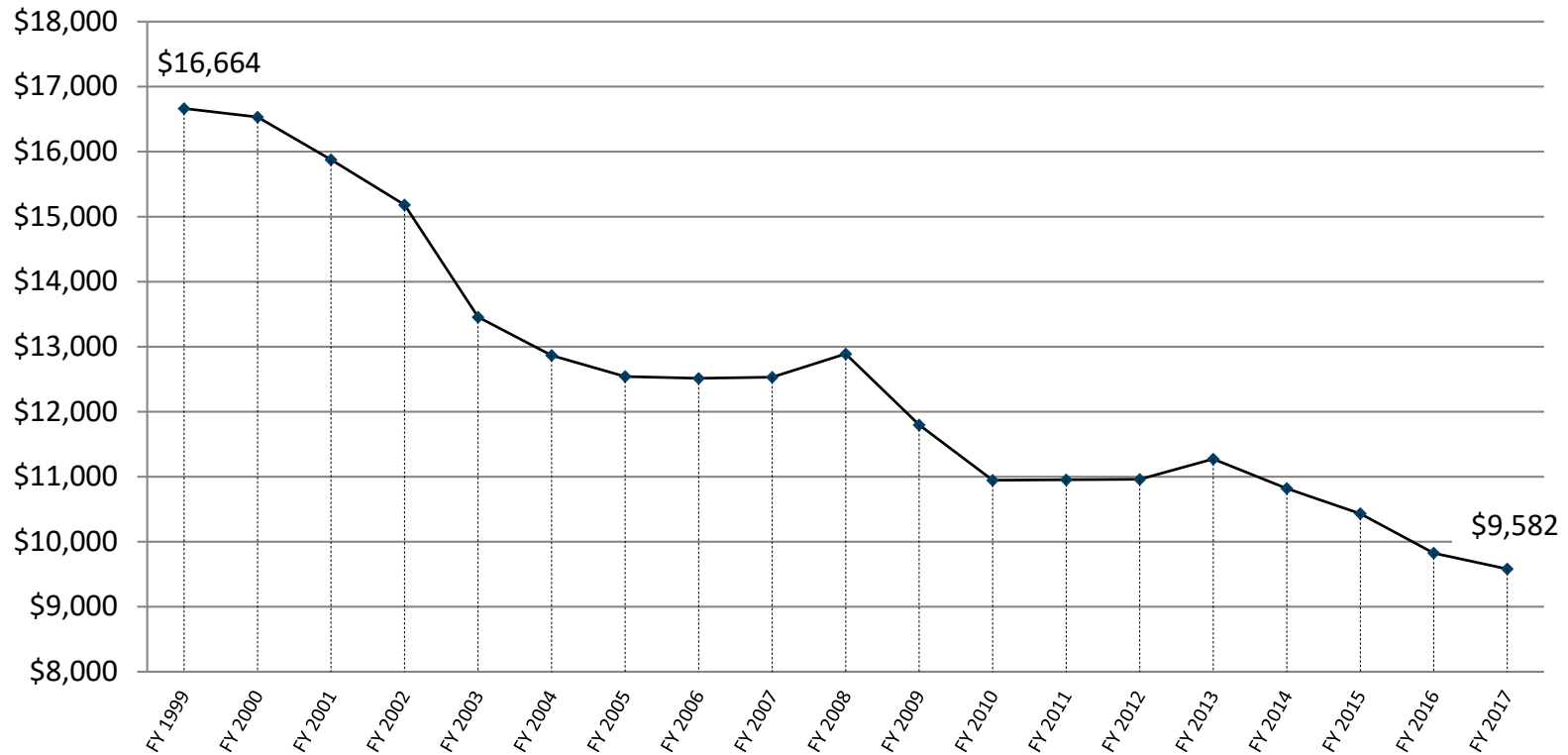
## Inflation outpacing state support
